Welcome to the first installment of FeedAC's monthly email updates. These email updates will go out at the end of every month to ensure that FeedAC's progress is shared in a timely manner. Here is a quick glimpse at December's activities.

- ❖ The latest screening data for 62 soybean products is now posted in the database section. We anticipate we will be in receipt of all data for these samples by the end of the year.
- ❖ 48 samples of DDGS and 65+ samples of fishmeal have now been split and will be submitted for initial screening analysis by the end of the year.
- ❖ For historical perspective, the feed library from the 21st edition of Morrison's Feeds and Feeding (1951) is now online in the database section.
- ❖ Data from DairyOne's feed composition library were compiled and analyzed with respect to analytes across all available feeds and crop years and then ranked by frequency of assay. This summary is now online in the database section.
- ❖ Receipt of the first NIR Instrument will take place on January 8, 2007 from Bruker Optics. A Bruker representative will be on sight to assist in the set up of the instrument and technical training. FeedAC is in discussions with other instrument manufactures in regards to receiving more instruments. More details will follow in the January update.
- ❖ The Membership committee (co-chaired by Dr's Ruurd Zijlstra and Bill Mahanna) has established the membership levels for 2007. Hence, the 2007 Membership Drive will commence as soon as possible.
